Background

Feb 21: FCRA C'tee aware of BCP study to install 150 chargeable parking bays (inc. road markings / signs / payment machines) across Friars Cliff

Mar 21: AGM - Independent WG formed from cross-area volunteers to oppose parking bays & propose alternatives. Regular Forum updates - more volunteers

Apr 21: WG developed plan of action. Dialogue with BCP Portfolio Holder, Traffic Department & Ward Councillors. Multiple Zoom & 3 On-Site meetings

May 21: WG proposed plans for: (1) Winter parking (SYL restrictions to apply year-round & remove winter CP charges) and (2) Road safety around Seaway Ave, ARR & road junctions

Jun 21: BCP dropped Parking Bay proposal / Rejected winter parking proposal / Agreed to an extensive study on Road Safety

Oct 21 - Mar 22: BCP develop Road Safety plans / Seek approvals / Prepare TRO & Public Consultation / Roll-Out Easter

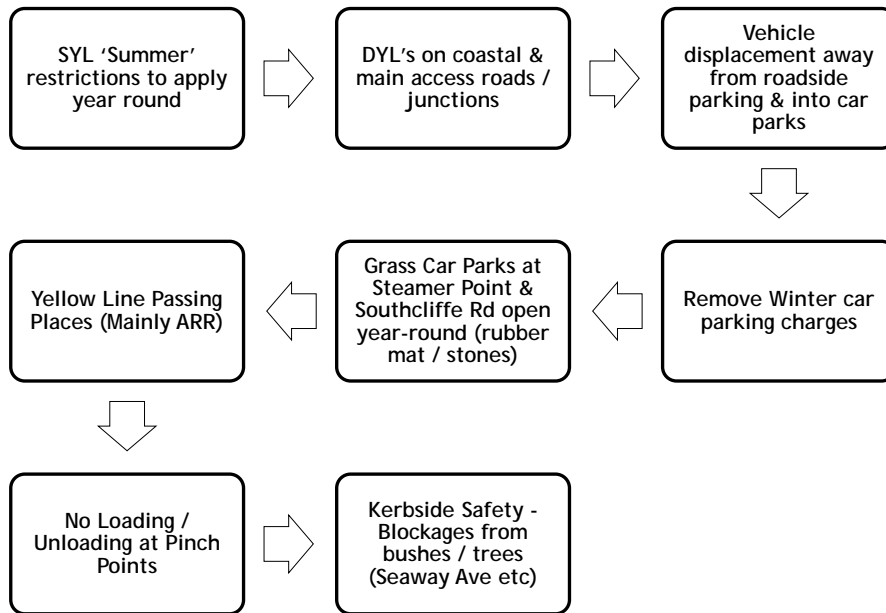

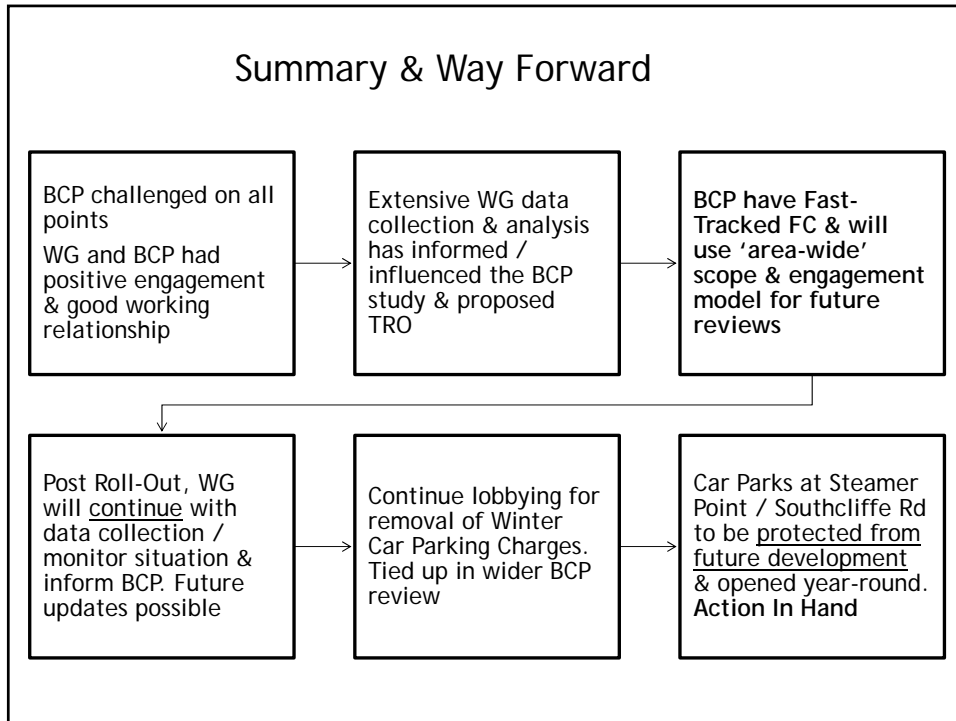
BCP Comments: Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) Process**Current Steps**

- TRO 21 Day Notice Period
 - *Begins today, Friday 4th March 2022*
 - *Ends Friday 25th March 2022*
- Notice in Daily Echo
- Notices on posts and lamp columns in the area
- Plans and details available on the BCP website
- Please respond to the link on the website - support, object or comments

BCP Comments: Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) Process**Next Steps - Legal and Democratic Process**

- Analyse and summarise responses
- Report, with recommendations, to Portfolio Holder, legal services & ward councillors
- Equality Impact Assessment
- Report signed off by Portfolio Holder - call in allowed
- Legal Orders signed and sealed - implementation date agreed
- Lines & signs ordered and implemented
- Depending on the number of responses this process can take 3 to 4 months
